These are to certifie That pursuant to an Order made the Session of Goal delivery of Newgate held for the City of London and County of Middx at Justice hall in the Old Baily on Wednesday the 10th day of October last Jonathan Forward of London Mercht hath given Security by Bond Severally to Simon Harcourt Esq and Randolph Stracey Gen Clerks of the peace of the City and County for the effectual Transporting to Maryland the within Named Sevl persons who then stood Convicted of Sevl Thefts and Larcenies And were Ordered by the Court for --Transportation according to the direction of an Act of parliamt in that case made and proved
